Entry fee: 15 Euro for Austrians, 5 Euro for foreigners (to be paid at the tournament), Late entries in big numbers will not be accepted! Single late entries are charged with 10 Euro in addition to the normal entry fee. **Teams are free**

Formula: the competition will be fenced according to the official FIE formula; there may be one or two group rounds

Team-event: Teams of three (shortened version, also see „Team-event), the formula of the team event depends on the number of participating teams); as usual a team fight consists of 9 single fights, but each fight only has 5 points (which means 5:0 or 4:1 or 3:2). As soon as a team has 23 points, it has won the fight. One single fight lasts 2 minutes at most. If the score is even in the end, there will be a play-off on one point which lasts one more minute. The leaders of each team can decide who fights in the play-off.

Referee: If you have three or more participants you have to bring one referee. If you have 10 or more, you have to bring two.

Safety: Safety regulations according to the FIE
