Registration / Entries

The competitions are open to all countries.

All entries for the Cadet tournaments must be made through the fencer's national federation via the EFC website www.eurofencing.info/registration.

Entry fee: €15 per fencer for the individual and €20 per team to be paid at check-in.

Competition format

- Two rounds of pools of 6-7 fencers, at least 20% eliminated after each round
 - Direct elimination with "repechage" starting from Tableau 32
- EFC regulations will apply throughout the competition.

Referees (according with EFC rules):

All referees must be entered through EFC the same way as the athletes.

- 1-4 fencers, no referee required
- 5-9 fencers, 1 referee
- 10-15 fencers, 2 referees
- 16-20 fencers, 3 referees

Non respect of quota is sanctioned by 300 EUR for every missing referee per competition.

In fact all the main hotels and guesthouses are well situated within the city providing easy access both to the downtown area and the venues of the Reykjavik International Games.
