<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b><i>All the entries must be nominated and submitted through their National Federations;</i></b></li><li>• Each country/ region may enter a maximum of eight (8) competitors in each event;</li><li>• Open Events Participants must be at least 13 years of age before 1 January 2015 (i.e. born in 2001 or before);</li><li>• Senior A Events Participants for senior A who must between 40 to 49 years old (born in 1966 to 1975)</li><li>• Senior B Events Participants for senior B who must be 49 years of age before 1st January 2015 (born in 1965 or before)</li></ul>

### Entry Fees

All events: US\$40 per person (For Non-HKID fencer)

### Enrollment

Entry by Number: On or before **9 October 2015** (Form1)

Entry by Name: On or before **28 October 2015** (Form2-4)

### Competition Management

- The fencing competition shall be conducted in accordance with the current Status and Rules of the FIE. In case of disagreement in interpretation of the rules, the latest English version shall prevail.
- The Director Technique (DT) shall deal with any unforeseen incidents not covered by the rules.

### Fencing Equipment

- Full fencing uniform and gear prepared by each participant. The mask and uniform must comply with the standard EN13567:2002 and 350N of the min. penetration resistance force. The mask must have two independent security devices.
- ***All participants must wear an 800N under-plastron which conforms to the FIE rules for taking part in the competition.***
- The ground supervisor shall disqualify any participant who doesn't comply with the uniform rules.
- Weapon Check will be held in the competition venue.

### Referee

Each country/ region participating in the competition must bring referees as follows:

- 5 -8 fencers = 1 referee
- 9 or more fencers = 2 referees

***Penalty fee for missing referee is US\$150 per day per referee.***

- Team Manager & Referee meeting will be held on 4 December 2015, 18:00 in Regal Oriental Hotel.

### Prizes

- One (1) gold, one (1) silver, and two (2) bronze medals to the top four (4) fencers
- Diplomas to the top eight (8) fencers
