



# EDEN CUP

## Men's Junior (U20) Foil

### FIE Category 'A'



The Eden Cup is open to all male foilists, foreign and British nationals possessing a current FIE Licence and born on or after 1 January 1985, who are selected by their National Federations in accordance with the FIE quota for entries to A Grade events.

**Please note – the Hotel and Venue are on the NW border of London and transport to the Centre of London is not easy or fast.**

- 1) **Date:** Saturday 23rd October 2004
- 2) **Venue:** Princess Marina Sports Centre, Royal Masonic School for Girls, Chorley Wood Road, Rickmansworth, Hertfordshire WD3 4HF

The nearest station is Rickmansworth served by Metropolitan Line trains from Baker Street (30 minutes) and by Chiltern Trains from Marylebone (less than 30 minutes)

Heathrow Airport is 20 minutes drive away, or use the 724 Airport Bus which goes direct from Heathrow Airport to Rickmansworth Station and runs hourly from 5.00 a.m.

From the M25 leave at junction 18 follow A404 towards Rickmansworth and the School is on the left.

Entries must list the fencers in order of strength. They must also give for each fencer his name, date of birth and FIE licence number.

Entries must include the names of officials and referees (With 5-9 fencers 1 FIE Referee must be sent, 10 or more fencers requires 2 FIE Referees) in accordance with FIE requirements. All entries should arrive in London no later than four days prior to the event

- 5) **Entry Fee:** The entry fee may be paid as £7 (Sterling), €10 (Euros), \$10 (US Dollars) or 12.5 CHF (Swiss Francs)
- 6) **Formula:** The competition will be fenced according to the official FIE formula.
- 7) **Programme:** Friday

- 8) **Doping:** Control will be carried out.
- 9) **Publicity:** The FIE Publicity Code will be strictly enforced.
- 10) **FIE Rules:** The Competition will run in accordance with the FIE Rules for Competitions. The Directoire Technique will, however, reserve the right to decide, without right of appeal, on any issues not covered by the FIE Rules or by these Rules.
- 11) **Referees:** Each country is required to send referees in accordance with FIE requirements. The names of referees, together with their FIE Category, must appear on the entry form.
- 12) **Accommodation: Booking accommodation is the responsibility of the visiting teams. The British Fencing Association cannot book hotels for delegations.**
