**FIE Satellite Event**

The Leon Paul Cup is open to all male foilists, foreign and British nationals possessing a current FIE Licence. This event is appointed by the FIE as satellite World Cup tournament. The final 8 will be awarded World Cup points

- 1) **Date:** Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> October 2004
- 2) **Venue:** Princess Marina Sports Centre, Royal Masonic School for Girls, Chorley Wood Road, Rickmansworth, Hertfordshire WD3 4HF

The nearest station is Rickmansworth served by Metropolitan Line trains from Baker Street (30 minutes) and by Chiltern Trains from Marylebone (less than 30 minutes)

Heathrow Airport is 20 minutes drive away, or use the 724 Airport Bus which goes direct from Heathrow Airport to Rickmansworth Station and runs hourly from 5.00 a.m.

From the M25 leave at junction 18 follow A404 towards Rickmansworth and the School is on the left.

Clubs and fencers must inform their national federation of their entry. A Federation entering more than four fencers is obliged by the FIE rules to send a referee, category A or B, to the tournament (10 or more entries: two referees). FIE sanctions will be enforced against those federations that do not comply with FIE rules.

All entries should arrive in London no later than 20<sup>th</sup> October accompanied by the entry fee which may be paid as £7 (Sterling), €10 (Euros), \$10 (US Dollars) or 12.5 CHF (Swiss Francs)

**GBR Entries**

The total entry to the event will be limited, with 75 places reserved for GBR fencers who will be chosen on the following basis:

- a. The 25 fencers selected for the Eden Cup – MUST ENTER BY 1 OCTOBER
- b. The top 25 from the British Senior Foil Rankings (as on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2003) – MUST ENTER BY 1 OCTOBER
- c. 25 other GBR fencers in the rankings allocated as entries are received. After October 1<sup>st</sup>, any "spare" places not taken up as in a & b will also be allocated to GBR fencers in the order in which entries have been received.
- d. **On the day** any remaining spaces will be allocated to GBR fencers

- 5) **Formula:** The competition will be fenced according to the official FIE Junior formula with one round of pools and DE without repechage.

- 7) **Publicity:** The FIE Publicity Code will be strictly enforced.
- 8) **FIE Rules:** The Competition will run in accordance with the FIE Rules for Competitions. The Directoire Technique will, however, reserve the right to decide, without right of appeal, on any issues not covered by the FIE Rules or by these Rules.
- 9) **Accommodation:** **Booking accommodation is the responsibility of the visiting teams. The British Fencing Association cannot book hotels for delegations.**
