



Camden International Cadet Sabre Competition 2007

Your National Sabre Team has been invited to enter the Camden International Cadet Sabre Competition, which will be held over the weekend of the 10th – 11th February 2007. Attached are the details of the event plus the entry form.

The event will be held in Tufnell Park, which is close to the Centre of London and approximately 45 minutes away by train from both Gatwick and Heathrow airports.

The tournament is being organized by Camden Fencing Club, which is a community programme organized and run by Camden Sports Council. British Fencing Association will be running the event.

This competition is important because it offers Cadets from around the world the opportunity to fence in London prior to the Olympics in 2012 when many will be aged 20-22 and therefore eligible to qualify for the Games.

This competition is already attracting to London some of the finest sabre talent and hopefully many competitors today will be here again competing in 2012.

The Mayor of Camden will be attending the competition and hosting a Civic Reception. Leading figures from the world of sports and politics will be invited.
