Directions and Bus Routes

UCD's Belfield campus is 3km south of Dublin City centre and depending on traffic, it should take you around 20 minutes to reach the campus from town by bus or car.

From City Centre (O'Connell Bridge)

The most direct route to take from O'Connell Bridge is as follows:

Cross O'Connell Bridge and go down D'Olier Street

Turn right onto College Street and follow the road left around Trinity College, continuing down Nassau Street

Take a right onto Kildare Street and when you reach Stephen's Green, go right onto Merrion Row

Merrion Row extends onto Baggot Street

Cross over Baggot Street Bridge and then turn right onto Waterloo Road

From the top of Waterloo Road take a left onto Morehampton Road

From here continue on straight down Morehampton Road, through Donnybrook Village and arriving onto the Stillorgan Dual carriageway (N11)

Stay on the dual carriageway, passing the RTE television studios on your left, until you come to the flyover

Take the left turn onto the slip road and cross the flyover and you will be delivered at the main entrance to UCD

Follow the signposts from the gate to the sports centre

From Airport/ Belfast

Take the N1 from Belfast passing the airport

Or

Join the N1 from the airport following the signposts

The NI merges onto the Swords Road, which in turn continues onto the Drumcondra Road And this then turns into Dorset Street

Continuing down Dorset Street, take a left onto Gardiner Street and continue down the road until you come to the Liffey

Follow the signs for O'Connell Bridge

From there follow the directions above

From Dun Laoghaire/ South County Dublin

Leaving the car terminal take a left turn at Crofton Road and follow the coast road towards Dublin

Crofton Road becomes Dunleary Road, then Longford Terrace, then Seapoint Avenue At the T Junction, take a left onto Newtown Avenue

Then take a right onto the N31 Blackrock bypass

Continue along this road, passing the Frascati Shopping Centre on your left

Take an immediate left turn onto Mount Merrion Avenue after Frascati centre

Continue up Merrion Avenue until you get to the top and then take a right onto the N11 Stillorgan Dual Carraigeway

Go along the N11 until you get to the slip road for UCD

Take a left up the slip road and then another left at the top of it

You are now at the main entrance to UCD

Follow the campus signposts to the sport's centre

Bus Routes to UCD

From Town The following buses go directly into the campus in UCD No. 3 No. 10 No. 11B (leaves you beside the sport's centre) All these buses go through the city centre and the fare to UCD is approximately €1.45

Other buses do pass the campus and will drop you at the Montrose Hotel – from here cross the flyover to the campus (entrance A) and you have about a 10 min walk to the sport's hall No. 63 No. 46A / 46B No. 84 All these buses go through the city centre and the fare to UCD is approximately €1.45

From Dun Laoghaire/ South Dublin

No. 63 (From Kilternan)
No. 46A (From Dun laoghaire)
No. 84 (From Bray)
All the above pass the main entrance (A) to the college and travel along the N11 from Foxrock Church
The fare to UCD will be between €1:30 and €1:45

The No. 17 bus also travels through the campus – either from Blackrock Dart station or Dolphin's Barn Sydney Parade and Booterstown DART stations are both approximately 20 minutes walk from the campus The DART travels along Dublin Bay from Howth to Bray (and back again) going through the city centre

A taxi from the city centre to the sport's hall should cost approximately €10, though this depends greatly on time of day, number of passengers etc The Aircoach from Dublin airport will leave you in Donnybrook where you can catch a

selection of buses to UCD The Aircoach costs €6
