Rules and legal	Double upgrading is allowed to the "Senior" category. In the "Cadets" (U17) and "Junior" (U20) categories only the single upgrade is allowed. In each individual event: - the title of "National Champion" is awarded to the first Luxembourgish fencer on condition that there are at least two (2) Luxembourgers participating in the event. - the title of "Federation Champion" is awarded to the first FLE license. - the title of "National Championship Winner" is awarded to the fencer ranked first in the event.		
Image / TV rights	Participants may be filmed or photographed during the event. These images may be used by the FLE promote their activities (posters, leaflets, flyers, website, social networks, etc.). Participation in this event implies that you authorize the FLE to use your image in all publications that fall within the framework described above.
