Dear Club President / Captain

It gives me great pleasure to invite you to the 7th London International Universities Fence-athon, LIUF 2002. Hosted and run by UCLU Fencing Club, it is the UK's only international student fencing competition and will be held during the weekend of 7th - 8th June, at Somers Town Community Sports Centre, London. Full details can be found in the information document enclosed.

LIUF was established in 1997 in conjunction with UCL and Johannes Gutenberg Universität Mainz (Germany) and has been growing rapidly ever since. Last year's competition, LIUF 2002, was the largest so far with approximately 160 participants. Every year we have received extremely positive feedback, and we have already had strong interest in LIUF 2003, which we hope to be even larger and more popular than last year's tournament.

There will be a mixed individual competition for each weapon, with recognition for the top three cumulative University/club results.

Additionally, accommodation is provided for a comparatively small fee on mats within the sports hall on Friday 6th and Saturday 7th. Fencers will need to bring a sleeping bag, but we will provide mats and a cooked breakfast, which is held at a greasy spoon café in close proximity to the venue, allowing for the mopping up of any excesses from the night before!

Finally, we gratefully acknowledge the support and sponsorship of Leon Paul Equipment Co. Ltd., KPMG, UCL Friends Trust the UCL Dean of Students and UCL Union, without whom we would not be able to run this year's event. Our thanks go out to all of them.


