Prizes will be awarded to the top 8 fencers and to the highest placed Under 18 fencer and Veteran at each weapon. Fencers must be members of a National Veterans Association to be eligible for the Veterans medals and must provide evidence of their membership. In accordance with BFA rules, all fencers must be aged 13 or over on 1 January 2005.

Plate competitions, for the Dorothy Knowles Swords, will be held at Men's Foil and Women's Foil.

The foil and sabre events will be fenced with boxes using the new timings introduced by the FIE on 1 October 2004.

Entries will be restricted to 96 fencers at each weapon. Reserve lists will be used when the entry limits are reached.

Late entries may be accepted at the organisers discretion. A surcharge of £5 will be made for all entries received after Saturday 29 January 2005. Entries received without fees will be classed as late.

Membership cards must be presented at check-in. Fencers without cards must take out BFA membership on the day.

#### Directions:

1. Approach Liverpool on A59, A580 or M62.

2. Turn left onto A5058 (Queens Drive - Ring Road).

3. Heading south along Queens Drive after the M62 junction, cross the first roundabout at Childwall Fiveways (pub on left).

4. After <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> mile cross second roundabout and immediately join middle lane for Queens Drive at traffic lights (straight ahead).

5. After  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile the road passes under a railway bridge.

6. After another 200 yards, turn right at traffic lights onto North Mossley Hill Road.

7. After 100 yards, Liverpool College is on the right.

## **BFA Membership**

The Merseyside Open is a BFA Registered Competition held under BFA rules. All competitors must hold Full, Junior or Senior (Over 60) membership of the BFA, or the equivalent membership of another national association, in order to take part in the tournament.

Membership cards must be presented at registration otherwise BFA membership must be taken out on the day. Please note that the BFA makes a £5 administration charge for returning fees paid in cash by fencers whose membership is subsequently confirmed. We regret that we are no longer able to accept declarations of membership, in accordance with BFA instructions. Fencers who are unable to present a current membership card and who cannot pay for BFA membership on the day will not be allowed to fence.

## **BFA Equipment Standards**

MOFT2005 will be applying the BFA equipment standards that will become mandatory for all tournaments from 1 January 2006. Random checks will be made on jackets, underplastrons, breeches and masks to ensure that they comply with the standards.
