Ladies and Gentlemen,

The modifications of the Calendar for the 2004-2005 season, listed below, have been submitted for approval to the Executive Committee, which has met on 14 January 2005 in Doha (QAT) :

Senior Women's Epee

The Fencing Federation of **Taipei** cancels its GP and Team competitions respectively scheduled on <u>6-7 and 8 May 2005 in</u> <u>Taipei</u> (TPE), because of a lack of sponsors.

The Fencing Federation of **South Africa** cancels its competition Candidate to A Category scheduled <u>on 11 and 12 June 2005 in</u> <u>Cape Town</u> (RSA) for financial reasons.

Senior Women's Sabre

The Fencing Federation of **Vietnam** cancels its competition Candidate to A Category scheduled on <u>5 and 6 February 2005 in</u> <u>Hanoi</u> (VIE) for reasons of "force majeure".

Senior Men's Epee

Exceptionally, the competition Candidate to A Category initially scheduled in Rio de Janeiro (BRA) on 17 and 18 June 2005 is replaced by the A Category competition « Jockey Club Argentino » **in Buenos Aires (ARG) on 18 and 19 June 2005**.

Senior Women's Sabre

For reasons of "force majeure", the **Jordanian** Fencing Federation postpones its GP and team competitions which were scheduled in Aqaba from 18 to 20 February 2005. <u>The competitions will be held from 20 to 22nd May, 2005.</u>
