Remarks	<p>All persons involved in the competition (fencer, supervisor, Officials, on-site organizers including temporary staff in the cafeteria, etc., medical Personnel, technicians,) must be in the Ophardt reporting system up to the corresponding Registration deadline and registered for the competition.</p> <p>A supervisor can be accredited for 1-3 fencers per club / nation - 2 supervisors can be accredited for 4-6 fencers per club / nation - 3 supervisors can be accredited for 7-10 fencers per club / nation - for more than 10 fencers per club / nation 4 supervisors can apply accredit.</p> <p>Any accompaniment such as trainer, physiotherapist, team doctor, own technician, etc. is considered to be a supervisor. At this point it is pointed out that according to the current FIE regulations, supervision of fencers by judges and officials is not permitted. All accompanying persons participating in a competition who are not accredited according to the above-mentioned key are considered spectators and can only be in the area that is accessible to spectators. It is not possible to enter areas for which accreditation is required. If the number of spectators is limited, people accompanying underage participants will be given priority at the entrance.</p> <p>Every profile in the Ophardt system, including profiles that have already been created and used, must contain the following data so that an accreditation can be issued:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- full name and date of birth- current adress- Telephone number and email address- Function (athlete, official, supervisor, etc.)- Current passport photo to be used for accreditation
