## **FIE Satellite Tournament on épée**

### **Open Danish Student Championships on foil and sabre Tournament for juniors and cadets on foil and épée**

### **September 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> 2006**

Jysk Akademisk Fægteklub hereby has the pleasure to invite you to the 51<sup>st</sup> JAF Jubilee Tournament held in the beautiful locations of Århus, Denmark. The Men's and Women's épée competitions are part of the Nordic FIE Satellite Tournament.

**Venue:** **DGI-Huset, Værkmestergade 17, 8000 Århus C, Denmark** (map enclosed)

**Organiser:** **Jysk Akademisk Fægteklub and the Danish Fencing Federation**

**Schedule:** **Saturday September 9th**

**Men's épée (senior): FIE Satellite Tournament** – calling 9.30 and start 10.00

Ladies' foil (senior) – calling 10.30 and start 11.00

Cadet and junior ladies' épée – calling 11.30 and start 12.00

Cadet and junior men's foil – calling 11.30 and start 12.00

Friendship night – start 20.00

**Sunday September 10th**

**Women's épée (senior): FIE Satellite Tournament** – calling 9.30 and start 10.30

Men's foil (senior) – calling 10.30 and start 11.00

Sabre (senior) – calling 11.30 and start 12.00

Cadet and junior ladies' foil – calling 12.00 and start 12.30

Cadet and junior men's épée – calling 12.00 and start 12.30

**Registration has to be done one hour before start.**

Minor alterations in the program are possible.

**Regulations:** For the épée competition the official rules for FIE Satellite Tournaments apply. For the rest of the tournament FIE rules with Danish modifications apply.

**Formula:** **Épée competition – Coupe du Nord:**

One pre-tournament round of poules with seeding given with priority to 1. fencers with FIE points, 2. fencers with Coupe du Nord points, 3. other fencers. All fencers entered must compete. No elimination. One round of poules "Tournament proper". Seeding based on indicators from the pre-tournament round. 20-30% of the fencers are eliminated after this round. Seeding for DE is based on indicators from 2. round only. Direct elimination will take place without repêchage to the final four.

**Other individual competitions:**

Two rounds of poules with no elimination from either. Seedings for the first round of poules as for the épée competition. Seeding for DE is based on indicators from both rounds of poules.

**Weapon control:** Masks will be checked at registration. For fencers in the épée competitions weapons will also be checked.

**Equipment:** FIE 800 newton jackets and breeches (knickers) and FIE 800 newton plastrons must be worn. Masks 1600 newton. FIE blades obligatory for the épée competitions.

**FIE license:** For the épée competitions FIE license is obligatory. Fencers without an FIE license or a valid receipt from ordering an FIE license will not be allowed to compete.

**Referees:** For every 4 fencers entered in the epee competition each club must provide a referee for a whole day or pay 100 € or 750 dkr.

**Doping control:** Doping control will take place in the épée competition.

**Fee:** One individual competition: 20 € / 150 dkr.  
Two individual competitions: 30 € / 225 dkr.  
Junior / cadet tournament: 15 € / 100 dkr.

**Friendship night:** We hope you will join us on friendship night celebrating the 51<sup>st</sup> JAF Jubilee Tournament. Location and price are to be announced on [www.jaf.dk/jaf2006](http://www.jaf.dk/jaf2006). Please subscribe for the friendship night on the website if participating.

**Entry:** All entries for the épée competition have to be made through the fencers' national fencing association to [jannie@8k.dk](mailto:jannie@8k.dk) no later than the 1<sup>st</sup> of September 2006.  
All other entries can be done using the online registration on [www.jaf.dk/jaf2006](http://www.jaf.dk/jaf2006) no later than the 1<sup>st</sup> of September 2006.

**Transport:** The tournament site is located just behind the central railway station of Århus.

**Hotels:** Booking of hotel is the responsibility of the visiting fencers. Check our website for accommodation ideas.

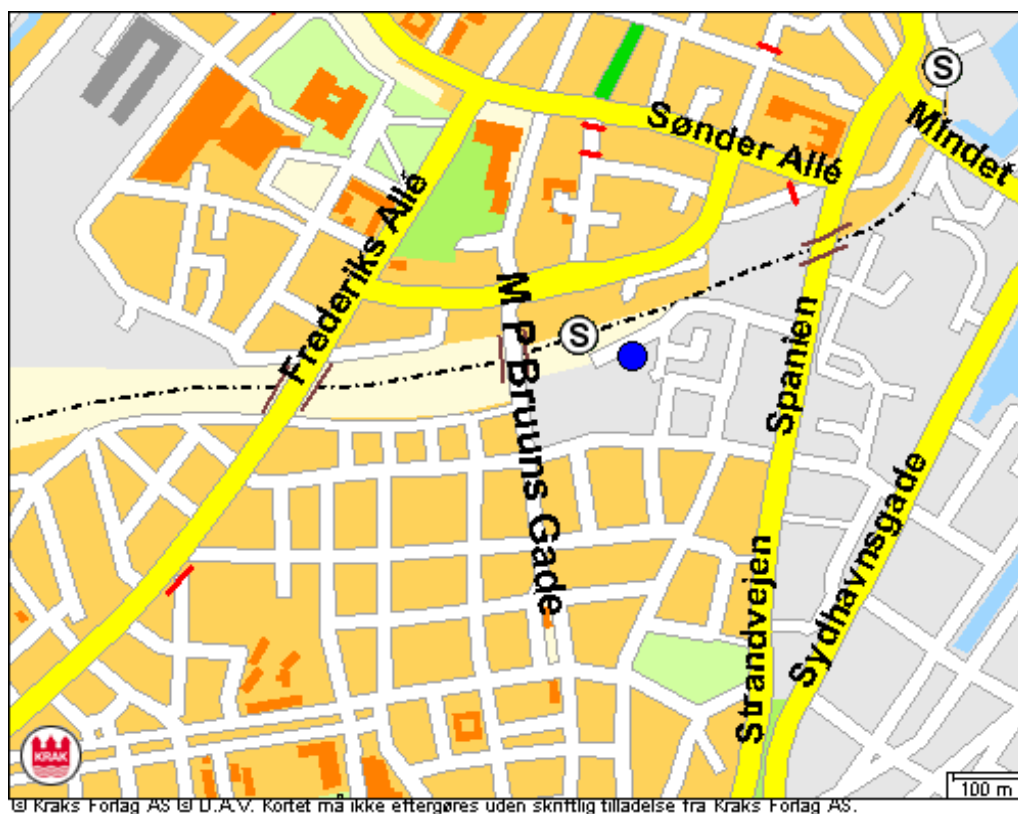

## Driving directions

DGI-Huset is located just behind the main railroad station. To get there by car take the road Værkmestergade from the road Spanien.



From the motor way take the exit "Århus Syd" and continue straight ahead in the first traffic light onto "Åhavevej". Continue straight ahead through 5 traffic lights (after 2 traffic lights Åhavevej turns into "Marselis Boulevard"). Just before you go down hill through a tunnel you must keep to the right to get onto "Strandvejen". Turn left down Strandvejen in direction of the center of Århus. Strandvejen continues into Spanien. Turn left up Værkmestergade.
