“Lundbystrandshallen” is a sports complex beautifully located by the river and the typical Gothenburg harbor. The history of fencing is in the walls as it used to host the CC/JWC Vigor Challenge, one of the world’s largest fencing competitions at its time.

Public Transport:

The closest bus stop is “Regnbågsgatan”, reachable by busses 16, 19, 21, 31, 99, and X1. The best option to pay for your ticket is to download the app “Västtrafik To Go” on your phone and purchase a single ticket from the app. Paying with credit cards on all buses and trams is also possible. Use the app to plan your route.

Car:

The venue is easily accessible by car, with a large parking lot right outside.



ELIGIBILITY

European Cadet Circuit

The CC events (U17) are open to U17 Boys and Girls born between 2007.01.01 and 2012.12.31. Fencers must be entered to the competitions by their national federation through the EFC website. Maximum 5 teams/nation are allowed to enter the team event.

All active participants, fencers, referees and coaches, must be in possession of the EFC license according to EFC-rules. Mixed teams can be registered by e-mail to wcc@goteborgsfk.se. Last day for registration is January 12th.

International Youth Competition

All fencers born 01.01.2009 or younger are welcome in the different age categories. The fencers must have a valid fencing license issued by their federation. All international fencers register either through Ophardt or by e-mail to wcc@goteborgsfk.se and all Swedish fencers register through Ophardt. Registration shall be done January 17th at the latest. Mixed teams will be allowed, but also need to register before deadline.

- U15 Men & Women Ind (born 2009 or younger)
- U13 Open Ind & Team (born 2011 or younger)
- U11 Open Ind (born 2013 or younger)

FORMULA

European Cadet Circuit

- Individual events
1 round of poules, followed by direct elimination without repechage. 20% eliminated after the poules. FIE JWC Formula.
- Team events
Direct elimination. All placements will be fenced for the best 16 teams.

International Youth Competition

- Individual events
2 rounds of poules, followed by direct elimination without repechage.
- Team events
Direct elimination. All placements will be fenced for the best 16 teams.



ENTRY FEES - CADETS

European Cadet Circuit

- Individual events – 25 euro/person
- Team events – 75 euro/team

All participants and participating teams must check in the day before their respective event.

Fees can be paid in advance or in the venue, by credit card only. The venue will be open on Friday 26th of January between 17.00-20.00, and all day on competition days. Please indicate by e-mail to wcc@goteborgsfk.se if you won't be able to make it in time for check-in on Friday.

Any federation can also choose to pay in advance, on January 17th at the latest. See more under “Bank details” below.



ENTRY FEES - YOUTH

International Youth Competition

- Individual events – 40 euro or 400 SEK/person
- Team event – 60 euro or 600 SEK/team

All participants and participating teams must check in one hour before start.

All fencers should pay in advance before January 17th. See more under “Bank details” below. If this is not possible for you, please contact us at wcc@goteborgsfk.se

No referee quota for the International Youth Competition. The organizer provides the referees, it's included in the entry fee.

Late registration is possible with an extra fee of 100 SEK or 10 Euro per person/team.

EQUIPMENT

European Cadet Circuit

FIE standard equipment and clothing will be required (800N clothing, 1600N Mask, FIE approved blades)

The electric bib will be compulsory used. Printing of the fencer's name on the back of the jacket is not required. EFC regulations will apply throughout the competition.

We expect an equipment shop to be available during Saturday and Sunday. Please follow our social media or visit our website for more information.

International Youth Competition

For U15 a 1600N mask is required, combined with at least 1 layer of 800N clothing (jacket or plastron).

For U13 & U11 no FIE-regulations apply, but the maximum blade size is size 2 in U13 and size 0 in U11.

All age categories will fence with the electric bib. Swedish Fencing Federation regulations will apply throughout the competition.

REFEREES EFC EVENT

European Cadet Circuit

Quota of referees in the individual competitions

- 0-3 fencers No referee
- 4-9 fencers 1 referee
- 10-15 fencers 2 referees
- 16-20 fencers 3 referees

Quota of referees in the team competitions

- 1-2 teams 1 referee
- 3-5 teams 2 referees

Failure to comply with this rule will result in a 500 euro fine for each referee short of the required number. This fee must be paid before any fencers from the offending country will be allowed to compete.

All referees must be entered the same way as the fencers, by their National Federations through the EFC website.

The referee seminar will be held on Saturday and Sunday, at 07.30 in the referee room at the venue, and be led by the EFC Delegate, who will provide evaluation of all referees during individual competitions. Participation is mandatory. Referee's age limit is minimum 18 and maximum 60 years of age.

Referee quotas are counted per category, not per day.



REFEREES U15-U11

No referees required. The organizer will provide the referee with the help of registration fees.

WEAPON CONTROL

European Cadet Competition

The weapon control will be done in the venue during the following time slots:

- Friday 26th of January at 17.00-20.00
- Saturday 27th of January, opens at 07.30
- Sunday 28th of January, opens at 07.30

Mask, electric jacket and glove will be checked.

For all guests as well as for fencers of Gothenburg Fencing Club, weapon control can be done on Thursday 25th of January at the club, between 18.00 and 21.00.

International Youth Competition

All weapon controls will be done by the referees on the piste.



ACCREDITATION FOR COACHES

All coaches

Every coach who wants an accreditation to the venue needs to register by e-mail to wcc@goteborgsfk.se providing us the name and position (head of delegation, coach, physio).

This must be done on January 17th at the latest.

Only accredited coaches will be allowed in the piste area. Parents and spectators who will stay in the stands do not need any accreditation.

There will be a Safeguarding officer on-site during the entire competition.

Coaches' Lounge

A coaches' lounge, open for all accredited coaches, will be available during the entire competition. Snacks and free lunch will be served.



FREE PRACTICE

Gothenburg Fencing Club

Gothenburg Fencing Club will be open for free training sessions for all delegations taking part in the competition, both the week leading up to the competition, AND the week after.

The club has top-of-the-line facilities, with 10 modern strips, a well-equipped gym for strength and conditioning, a kitchen, and changing rooms with the possibility to shower.

Gothenburg Fencing Club is one of Sweden's oldest and most successful fencing clubs, collecting medals at the Olympics, World Championships, and European Championships. It's been the most successful foil fencing club in Sweden for more than 10 years.
