Weapons

Floret - Epee - Saber (Women and Men)

Target group Ferrum Vetus:

Veteran Fencers born in 1982 or earlier may participate.

Students and novice fencers who are younger than the veteran age must meet the following conditions:

- Futuri must be at least 19 years old. With this we offer members of university fencing associations an opportunity to participate.
- Futuri may not be in the top thirty in the senior ranking. Futuri in women's epee and foil are not allowed access when they're in the top twenty and for women's saber not in the top ten in the senior ranking. Of course, this does not apply to veterans who are on these higher positions in the senior rankings.

All participants must be members of the KNAS, the FIE or the fencing federation of another country.

Format:

Depending on the number of participants. If less than 4 fencers register on one weapon, the competition on that weapon will not be fenced. If this is the case, subscribers will be notified via the registered e-mail address.

All participants (both in Ferrum Vetus and Ferrum Vetus Futuri) will be grouped per weapon. The individual results are registered per age category and per gender (m/f).

Based on the best results of four tournaments, exchange prizes will be awarded during the first tournament of the new year for the Ferrum Vetus participants for:

- the best man and woman per age category per weapon; exchange price with souvenir;
- the first placed man/woman overall per weapon.

Refereeing:

The participants will mutually have to referee their bouts.









Competition tournament:

The Ferrum Vetus tournament was established in 2004 to offer veterans (40 years and older) an attractive and challenging recreational fencing tournament several times a year. Since 2008, the tournament has also been open to fencers who are over 18 but under 40. We call this the Ferrum Vetus Futuri tournament which is an integral part of the Ferrum Vetus tournament.

The tournament is held several times a year at varying locations in the Netherlands and is organized by the KNAS and various fencing associations.
