

Veterans Competition

2nd Ferrum Vetus 2025

Arnhem, Sunday March 9th, 2025

Organisation: F.C. Scaramouche ([S.V. Scaramouche](#)) and the task force KNAS Veterans.

Formally, this is a veterans tournament, but Futuri are also welcome under certain conditions.

Veterans: Fencers born in 1985 or earlier. There will be no fencing in age categories.

Futuri: These are students and novice fencers who are younger than the veteran age and they must meet the following conditions:

- Futuri must reach or already have reached the age of 20 in the current calendar year. With this we offer members of university fencing associations an opportunity to participate.
- Futuri men may not be in the top thirty in the senior ranking. Women participating in this tournament on epee and foil are not allowed access if they are ranked in the top twenty and for women's sabre not in the top ten of the senior ranking. Of course, this doesn't apply to veterans highly ranked in the senior rankings. (Dutch seniors see: <https://knas.onzeranglijsten.net>)

In case of low numbers of registrations for ladies and/or gentlemen, the gentlemen and ladies will be merged into one category.

All participants must be a member of the KNAS, the FIE or a fencing federation affiliated with the FIE from another country.

League Match:

The tournament is held several times a year. At the end of each year (Jan-Dec) a ranking is drawn up over the 4 best results of that year. In the overall ranking, the first placed man and woman per weapon receive the overall challenge trophy. In addition, the best man and woman per age category and per weapon will receive a challenge trophy. During the first Ferrum Vetus tournament the award ceremony could not take place. That is why it will take place during this second tournament.

Tournament format:

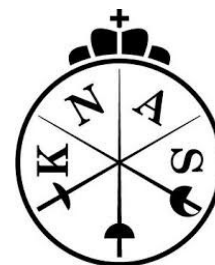
A preliminary round will take place first, after which the elimination tableau will be determined. Insofar as time allows, the tableau will be fenced, as far as time limits allow us.

If fewer than 4 fencers are entered on one weapon, the match on that weapon will not be fenced. If possible, registered fencers will be informed if their e-mail address is known to the FV-organisation..

Refereeing:

The Ferrum Vetus tournament participants includes a sufficient number of suitably qualified referees. To self-referee the bouts.

Registering for a Dutch competition through Nahouw

If you are a foreign competitor wishing to register for a Dutch tournament through the Nahouw, please follow the instructions below:

2. Think of a username, Suggestion: initials+lastname (e.g. "jjones")
3. Think of a password (min. 12 characters), enter it twice
4. Enter your first name
5. Enter your last name
6. Select your gender
7. Select your country
8. Select your club if it is listed, otherwise leave it on "-"
9. Enter your email address
10. Register
11. You'll receive a confirmation email

13. Change your language and date of birth if needed
14. Go to the tournament you wish to register for
15. Select your weapon and submit
16. You've just registered
17. You'll receive an email confirmation of the registration
