

# The *Invicta* Open

*Please note that the competition will be run using the new foil and sabre timings throughout. Leon Paul will supply the kit and also provide on-line entry facilities on their Web site if required.*

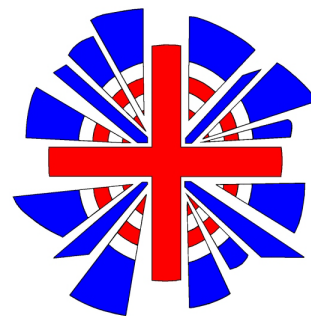
