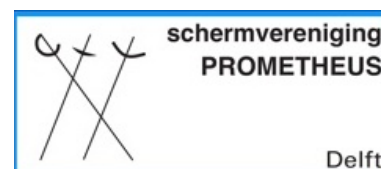
Depending on the numbers of participants one or two preliminary rounds will be fenced. After the preliminary rounds we will proceed with direct elimination rounds without second chance. If there is a shortage of female participants the preliminary rounds will be fenced mixed. If there is a shortage of referees, the participants will be asked to judge matches themselves. The finals of sabre are expected to start around 12:00 and those of epee around 17:00. There will be a joint awards ceremony at the end of the day.

Rules

All matches will be fenced according to FIE rules. This means the new time for sabre and no twisted mask cable are allowed.

Directions

The Unit Sports & Culture (building 37 on the map) is located on the campus of the Delft University of Technology. Parking is available across the road from Unit Sports & Culture (parking Sports on map).

By car:

Coming from the direction of Rotterdam or The Hague along highway A13, take exit 10 Delft-Zuid/TU Delft and follow the signs TU Delft. At the end of the exit, take a right (Schoemakersstraat). Driving on the Schoemakersstraat, take the first turn to the left. Drive over the bridge at the left hand side to arrive at the parking lot (Parking Sports). Unit Sports & Culture is situated at the end of the parking lot.

Public transport:

Unit Sports & Culture is also reachable by train:

- Station `Delft-Zuid` is the closest station and is only 10 minutes of walking away from Unit Sports & Culture
- It is also possible to travel via station `Delft-Centraal`. From here it is about 25 minutes walking to Unit Sports & Culture.
