Team competition

Three persons in every team (3 + 1) - boys or girls or mixed.

Your club may register one or several teams in the same class

Regulations

FIE - rules and SVFF - security rules.

Direct elimination or poule system depending on the number of fencers.

Formula

Seeding will be based on factors known to the leaders of the competition.

Fee

Euro 10 or SEK 90 per capita plus Euro 15 or SEK 140 per team which can be paid by registration or by giro in connection to your entry.

Weapon and security control

Weapons and security will be checked on the piste by the referee.

Referees

1 - 3 fencers = 0 referee

4 - 7 fencers = 1 referee per day

8 - 12 fencers = 2 referees per day

13 - 17 fencers = 3 referees per day

18 - fencers = 4 referees per day

Every club - Swedish or foreign - sending four fencers or more must also send referee(s)

A fine of Euro 100 or SEK 900 per day must be paid for every referee that a club is unable to present in accordance with the stipulations above.

As the referees are to be accepted by the leaders of the competition, the names of the referees should if possible be stated in the entries.

Cafeteria

MF 19 will sell beverages, sandwiches etc. during competition hours.

Special attraction

A traditional **Swedish Lucia Day procession** will take place at the end of the competitions of the first day (Saturday).
