Objective: Fencing and German Beer

This camp's objective is to provide a superior international fencing environment with an emphasis on competitive bouts (both team and individual) and technical and tactical skills. However, the staff plans to be flexible to meet the needs of each camper. There will be both group and individual instruction. There will be one camp session each day. In addition, camp will include trips to Munich tourist sites, scheduled beer tasting, dinners and the “International Bavarian Veterans Championship” tournament.

Fencing Masters and Armorer



Michael Marx – Michael earned his Master of Arms degree in Poland in 1992. Michael is a five-time Olympian and the only male fencer in the last 60 years to make the U.S. Olympic team in two weapons: foil and epee. He is a five-time USOC Athlete of the year and earned a record eight U.S. national championships in foil. He has had students on the last five Olympic teams. He has been inducted into both the USFA and Oregon Sports Hall of Fame. Michael now resides in Concord, Ma and runs the Marx Fencing Academy.



Thomas Theuerkauff – Fencing Master, Thomas earned his Master of Arms degree in Germany in 1982. He is a four-time German Champion and winner of the Champions League (Coupe d'Europe des Clubs) in 1989. Thomas made several World-Cup Finals and was ranked for over 10 years in the World Top-Twenty. Since 2000, he is coaching the Medoc Fencing Club in France.



Giorgio Guerrini – German Master of Arms degree, Giorgio is an Italian coach with international experiences. During his 25 years career he has been working as national coach and club coach in Europe, Central America and Asia. His students have won the Swiss Championships and the Danish Championships, and won medals at the Asian-Games. He is presently Head Coach at MTV, Munich, Germany.

Giorgio will also be our armorer during the camp.

Number of participants: The number of participants is strictly limited to 49 (campers and spouse) in order to guarantee the quality of individual coaching and keep the camp convivial.

Cost:

The camp fee is \$2165.00* inclusive of housing (7 Nights at Hotel Herzog including breakfast). Fencing Camp Only: \$750.00*. Afternoon activities and Beer-tour: \$890.00*, which includes lunch and all afternoon-trips, visits, scheduled beer tasting and dinners
