

BRITISH FENCING ASSOCIATION CORBLE CUP 2003

Men's Sabre FIE Category 'A'



The Corble Cup is open to all Men Sabreurs, possessing a current FIE Licence, who are selected by their National Federations in accordance with the FIE Quota for entries to A Grade Events.

- **1) Date:** Saturday and Sunday 25th and 26th January 2003

The nearest station is Shenfield, go from Liverpool Street Station, fast trains take about 25 minutes, from the station buses run to Brentwood and taxis are available.

Stanstead Airport is 40 minutes drive away – the Stanstead Express goes directly to Liverpool Street Station and, if arranged in advance, it may be possible to collect teams.

Heathrow and Gatwick Airports are 70 minutes drive away or ask at the airports for the best way by train to Liverpool Street Station.

Driving: From the M25 leave at junction 28 follow A1023 towards Brentwood, go straight through High Street, straight on over a double roundabout at the end (signposted Chelmsford) and the first right is Middleton Hall Lane. The School entrance is 300 metres on the right.

Entries must list the fencers in order of strength. They must also give for each fencer his name, date of birth and FIE licence number.

Entries must include the names of officials and referees (With 5-9 fencers 1 FIE Referee must be sent, 10 or more fencers requires 2 FIE Referees) in accordance with FIE requirements. All entries must arrive in London no later than 21st January.

- 5) Entry Fee: The entry fee may be paid as £10, €17, \$15 (USA) or 25CHF.
- 6) Formula: The competition will be fenced according to the official FIE formula.

- 8) **Doping:** Control will be carried out.
- 9) **Publicity**: The FIE Publicity Code will be strictly enforced.
- 10) FIE Rules: The Competition will run in accordance with the FIE Rules for Competitions. The

Directoire Technique will, however, reserve the right to decide, without right of appeal, on any issues not covered by the FIE Rules or by these Rules.

11) Referees: Each country is required to send referees in accordance with FIE requirements. The names of referees, together with their FIE Category and FIE membership number, must appear on the entry form.

12) Accommodation: Booking accommodation is the responsibility of the visiting teams. The British Fencing Association cannot book hotels for delegations.

Bed and Breakfast for a single room is £32 (€50) per night, or for a twin or double £44 (€72) per night.

Bookings must be made directly with the Hotel – quoting "Fencing".

Driving Directions to the Holiday Inn Basildon:

Leave M25 at jet 29, follow A127 toward Southend & turn off at junction A176 Basildon/ Billericay. At 1st roundabout turn left, at 2nd roundabout go straight across. Turn left at 3rd roundabout and go straight across 4th roundabout taking left slip road.

By train use the C2C train from Fenchurch Street to Basildon and then a taxi is advisable.

13) Transport:

A shuttle will run between the Holiday Inn Hotel and the Venue, calling at Shenfield Station, before and after the event each day.
