Participation	◆ Each country/ region may enter a maximum of eight (8) competitors in each individual event;	
	◆ Each country/ region may enter a maximum of one (1) team in each team event;	
	◆ <u>Senior Events</u> Participants who must be 13 years of age before 1 January 2016 (born in 2002 or before);	
	◆ <u>Master A Events</u> Male participants for master A who must be between 40 to 49 years old before 1 January 2016 (born between 1967 to 1976);	
	Female participants for master A who must be between 35 to 49 years old before 1 January 2016 (born between 1967 to 1981)	
	♦ Master B Events	
	All participants for master B who must be 50 years of age before 1 January 2016 (born in 1966 or before)	
	◆ Entry fee is non-transferable and non-refundable in any circumstances;	
	◆ Each participant can participate in only one event for each day;	
	◆ Registration of entries of any event of fewer than 4 fencer will be cancelled;
