FIE Satellite Tournament on épée

Open Danish Student Championships on foil and sabre Tournament for cadets and juniors on foil and épée

November 17th and 18th 2007

Jysk Akademisk Fægteklub hereby has the pleasure to invite you to the JAF Jubilee Tournament held in Århus, Denmark. The senior Men's and senior Ladies' épée competitions are part of the Nordic FIE Satellite Tournament.

Venue: Hasselagerhallen, Koltvej 39, 8361 Hasselager

Organiser: Jysk Akademisk Fægteklub and the Danish Fencing Federation

Schedule: **Saturday November 17th**

Men's épée (senior): FIE Satellite Tournament – calling 9.30 and start 10.00

Ladies' foil (senior) – calling 9.45 and start 10.15

Sabre (senior) – calling 10.30 and start 11.00

Cadet ladies' foil, cadet men's épée, junior ladies' épée and junior men's foil – calling 12.30 and start 13.00

Friendship night – start 20.00

Sunday November 18th

Women's épée (senior): FIE Satellite Tournament – calling 9.30 and start 10.00

Men's foil (senior) – calling 9.45 and start 10.15

Cadet ladies' épée, cadet men's foil, junior ladies' foil and junior men's épée – calling 10.30 and start 11.00

Registration has to be done one hour before start.

Minor alterations in the program are possible.

Regulations: For the épée competition the official rules for FIE Satellite Tournaments apply. For the rest of the tournament FIE rules with Danish modifications apply.

Formula: **Senior épée competition – Coupe du Nord:**

One pre-tournament round of poules with seeding given with priority to 1) fencers with FIE points, 2) fencers with Coupe du Nord points, 3) other fencers. All fencers entered must compete. No elimination. One round of poules "Tournament proper". Seeding based on indicators from the pre-tournament round. 20-30% of the fencers are eliminated after this round. Seeding for direct elimination is based on indicators from 2. round only. Direct elimination will take place without repêchage to the final four.

Other senior competitions (foil and saber):

Two rounds of poules with no elimination from either. Seedings for the first round of poules as for the épée competition. Seeding for direct elimination is based on indicators from both rounds of poules.

Cadet and junior competitions (foil and épée):

One round of poules with no elimination. Everybody to direct elimination.

Weapon control: Masks will be checked at registration. For fencers in the senior épée competitions weapons will also be checked.

Equipment: FIE 800 newton jackets and breeches (knickers) and FIE 800 newton plastrons must be worn. Masks 1600 newton. FIE blades obligatory for the senior épée competitions.

FIE license: For the senior épée competitions FIE license 2007/2008 is obligatory. Fencers without an FIE license or a valid receipt from ordering an FIE license will not be allowed to compete.

Referees: Senior épée competitions: As per FIE rules
Other competitions: 1-3 fencers = 0 referee
4-7 fencers = 1 referee through out the day
8-11 fencers = 2 referees through out the day
12-16 fencers= 3 referees through out the day
17 or more = 4 referees through out the day
For every 4 fencers entered in the other competitions each club must provide a referee for a whole day or pay 100 € or 750 dkr.

Doping control: Doping control will take place in the senior épée competition.

Fee: One individual competition: 20 € / 150 dkr.
Two individual competitions: 30 € / 225 dkr.
Junior / cadet tournament: 15 € / 100 dkr.

Friendship night: We hope you will join us on friendship night celebrating the JAF Jubilee Tournament. Location is to be announced on www.jaf.dk.
Please subscribe for the friendship night on the website if participating.

Entry: All entries for the senior épée competition have to be made through national fencing association according to FIE rules.
All other entries can be done using the online registration on www.jaf.dk no later than the 9th of November 2007.

Transport: The tournament site is reached within easy access from motorway E45 and from town with bus lines 15, 26, 52 and 107.

Hotels: Booking of hotel is the responsibility of the visiting fencers. Check our website for accommodation ideas.
