The participants will be divided into two groups according to their age appearing on the passport and they can fence only in these categories:

Category A: 50 to 59 years old at September 1st 2004 Category B: 60 years and older at September 1st 2004

The participants will have to present the following documents at the time of the accreditation:

Passport, FIE licence 2003/2004, medical certificate (attesting the aptitude of the participants to practice fencing) and discharge of responsibility (signed letter).

Prizes:

Gold, silver, and two bronze medals, as well as diplomas for each category

Formula:

Pools of 6 or 7 fencers, bouts of 5 hits of 3 minutes. After the pools direct elimination of 10 hits, 2 rounds of 3 minutes, with one minute break between each round. In sabre 1 minute break after 5 hits. A consolation round is planned for the eliminated fencers. If there are less than 10 fencers in a category: single pool.

Registration:

The number of entries per federation is limited to 4 participants per country, age group, and weapon. According time schedule double or triple entries of fencers are allowed where possible.

Entries must be sent by the national federation of each participant to the Austrian Fencing Federation / Mrs. Sonja Arnberger, with a copy to the FIE office in Lausanne before August 10th 2004, deadline.



An entry fee of \in 55 per participant per weapon has to be paid to the Austrian Fencing Federation on the spot in cash and inlcudes the Gala dinner on sunday, september 5.

Referees:

Participating delegations must be accompanied by the number of A or B category referees provided for by article o. 88 of the rules: 1 – 4 fencers = no obligation 5 – 9 fencers: 1 referee 10 or more fencers: 2 referees

Equipment of fencers

The personal equipment of fencers must comply to the FIE rules A control of the equipment will take place the day before the competition.

Travel and stay

Traveling, accommodation and boarding expenses are the responsibility of the participants.

Program 4	HEURIGEN IN KREMS/WACHAU		
	Typical for the Eastern part of Austria (where the most wine is growing) are the so called Heurigen. In former times they have been small, very simple equipped locations where you could drink the "new" wine of the current year. This wine is called in Austria "Heuriger" and so the places are called like this wine. In the new time these Heurigen are offering different old an new wines and a local kitchen suiting to the wine.

Program 5	Visit of the KLOSTER UND		
	This former capuchin cloister, desecrated in 1796, is today the "Weinkolleg" - the so called 'House of Lower Austrian Wines'. It offers an attractive atmosphere for activities around wine. One can sample and buy more than 100 exclusive wines from Lower Austria in the historic cellars. A guided tour as well as wine- seminars is bookable.

Program 6	SWIMMING WINE CELLAR – THE DIFFERENT WAY TO MEET WINE ON THE DANUBE RIVER		
	Start at 2.00 or 3.00 p.m. with a Wachau ship from Foerthof, going up the Danube to Spitz and back, tasting the wines of those vineyards we will pass. You will taste some great wines known all over the world like Jamek, Hirtzenberger, Knoll,

Program 7	WEINSTADTmuseum		
	The WEINSTADTmuseum was opened in 1996 in the former Dominican Monastery in the old town of Krems. It is here, where you find out more about the wine growers of Krems, the influence of the Danube and the importance of wine-growing for the development of this town. In the historical halls of the Dominican Monastery you get the chance to admire precious ancient objects while enjoying the advantages of today's high technology.

Program 8	STIFT GOETTWEIG is one of cultural heritages of our country		
	Benedictine Abbey Goettweig is situated in 449m above sea level, south of the town Krems at the Danube. Benedictine Abbey Goettweig (founded in 1083) is also called the "Montecassino of Austria"!		
	The baroque monastery facility was rebuilt by the imperial court architect Johann Lukas von Hildebrandt after a fire had nearly completely destroyed the monastery in 1718. The show-rooms in the museum, the monumental emperor stairs crowned by the impressive ceiling fresco created in 1739 by Paul Troeger (1698-1762).

Program 9	BOAT TRIP ON THE DANUBE		
	Pass through one of the most scenic parts of the river Danube and enjoy the rough and beautiful landscape during a trip on board of one of the shipsThe Wachau - one of the most impressive regions along the river Danube in the heart of Austria, skirted by the ruins of medieval castles, baroque abbeys and picturesque vineyards.
