Rules

The tournament will be run in accordance with the FIE rules for competitions. The Directoire Technique reserve the right to decide, without right of appeal, on any issues not covered by these rules.

Referees

The organisers will make every attempt to ensure that sufficient referees are available for all stages of the tournament. However, it would aid the smooth running of the competition if clubs entering a significant number of fencers could provide additional, qualified referees.

Accommodation

The booking of accommodation is the responsibility of competing fencers. The organisers cannot book hotels on their behalf.

Transport

Bolton Arena is located just off junction 6 of the M61. It is within 24 miles (40Km) of Manchester airport and 18 miles (30Km) of central Manchester.
